#### THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND AS YOU PLAN

1. You must use high school texts.
2. High School Level Courses may be taken in 8<sup>th</sup> grade with Administrative Approval.
3. High school English includes a combination of grammar, spelling/vocabulary, literature and composition.
4. Science labs are not separate credits. Lab grades are combined with textbook class grades.
5. Elective requirements are determined by the type of diploma desired and major areas of interest.
6. Generally IRSC classes are 0.5 credits. Some English, math, science w/ lab, and all 4-credit foreign language courses may be worth a full credit. 8. Bible classes should have specific names, i.e. Old Testament, New Testament, etc.
